A Note about this Service: A service of lessons & carols for Christmas was first developed in 1880 by Bishop Edward Benson of Truro (later Archbishop of Canterbury), and an adaptation by King's College, Cambridge, became famous. This iconic Christmas liturgy has been further adapted, using readings and carols to narrate the story of God's loving purpose in creation, from the Spirit of God which moved over the waters at the beginning of time, to the redemption of the world by Christ Jesus, the timeless Word made flesh.
